All surface and/or ground water must be diverted around sewage system.

An approved on-site sewage management system (port-a-john) is required during the construction phase.

Owner must identify location of all wells on and within 100' of property.

Call (770)781-6910 or (770)781-6909 between 8:00 - 9:00am for inspections.

New installations require a current level 3 soil report. Level 3 soil reports are recommended for all repair situations.
